Mike Turner: The Northwest Youth Corps used the dollars to create a program called OutDoor Oregon to give 16 to 19 year olds jobs working on conservation projects. Youth Corps Director, Keith Brown says its paying off for some of these kids

Keith Brown: For someone whos intersted in conservation work, alot of our young folks who go through our program actually go onto careers with the forest service, and parks, and those types of things.

Mike Turner: Jobs were created from money handed down to the Northwest Youth Corps, the Corps deputy director, Keith Brown, says the new program called OutDoor Oregon was created from it.

Keith Brown: We wanted to take with this funding, to get a program that we could start and continue on long after the funding was gone.

Mike Turner: Brown says many of the jobs will transition to state agencies and forest management companies.

Keith Brown: to things such as parks, wildlife areas, some stream rehabilitation, doing alot of trail work, invasive species removal.
