



# YOUTHGROW PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

Thank you so much for your interest in YouthGrow. We've been working very hard on developing the program, as YouthGrow is new this year. What we have below is a general daily outline, although we will be continuing to add more activities and field trips, therefore this schedule is subject to change.

8:30-9 - Drop off: 2621 Augusta St. Eugene, OR 97403

9- 9:15 - Gather into Group

9:15-9:45 – Circle up, team building activity, present the plan for the day

9:45 –12 Head toward Garden. Gardens will include over a dozen School Garden Project sites, as well as the Laurel Valley Education Farm at the Youth Grow site.

12:15- 1 – Lunch and relaxation time. Children will be expected to bring a sack lunch.

1- 1:15 – Gather back at Youth Grow site, present Choice Time Activities.

1:30- 2:30 – Choice Activity # 1

2:30 – 2:45 – Rotate

2:45 – 3:45 – Choice Activity # 2

3:45 – 4:15 – All Group Activity, quick daily wrap up, short overview of what to expect the next day

4:15- 4:30 – Clean-Up

4:30 – 5:30 – Evening pick up time. (Staff will facilitate field games and an Arts and Crafts area for youths waiting on their parents). Pick up is also at 2621 Augusta Street.

- Choice Activity: Each day Youth will be able to choose 2 of 3 activities which will include, garden crafts, creating a solar oven, making plant presses, cooking, and much more! Staff will rotate these activities so that youth will have a chance to partake in every activity if they so choose.
- The first two Fridays will be dedicated to an all day educational field trip with interactive activities, with half day field trips taking place throughout the week. Field trips will include (but are not limited to) visiting local farms, nature hikes, water quality testing, berry picking, visiting the Raptor Center, etc...
- The last Friday of Youth Grow Camp (Week Three) we will celebrate our time together by inviting families to come out for a youth created lunch, tour of the garden, and garden craft display! Families will be invited to come at 1:30pm and stay as long as they please, you can take your child with you after the lunch celebration is over, but camp will remain open for pick up until 5:30.
