

WHO WE ARE

Since 1984, Northwest Youth Corps (NYC) has been transforming the lives of youth and young adults by helping them to learn, grow, and achieve success. Our programs include residential conservation crews for youth and young adults, local community based conservation, forestry, and wildfire protection crews, an internship program, and a fully accredited chartered high school.

Through these programs, NYC members acquire essential job skills, life skills, and a comprehensive educational curriculum. Each participant emerges with invaluable experience in leadership and teamwork, the resilience to tackle challenges head-on, the ability to set and attain high expectations, a strong work ethic, and a spirited sense of adventure that boosts their self-confidence.

In 2024, nearly 1,200 youth and young adults earned paychecks, gained academic credit, and secured professional references, all while contributing over 200,000 hours of vital conservation service to our public lands and communities.

No matter where their journeys lead, the experiences our alumni gain at NYC lay a powerful foundation for each of them to create the unique masterpiece of their lives.






